## THE FIFTH DIMENSION TO PERFORM AT THE AMERICAN HOME FURNISHINGS HALL OF FAME INDUCTION CELEBRATION

"Up, Up and Away" and "Aquarius/Let the Sun Shine In" were inducted into the Grammy Hall of Fame, and The 5<sup>th</sup> Dimension has a star on the Hollywood Walk of Fame.
