














Last Call: Only Two Spots Remaining for the Leadership Institute



Nominations for Induction into the American Home Furnishings Hall of Fame

Nominations for the Class of 2024 for induction into the American Home Furnishings Hall of Fame, the industry's most prestigious award, are now open. All members of the American Home Furnishings Hall of Fame Foundation are eligible to nominate and to second a nomination.

To qualify for consideration, the individual being nominated must conduct business in the United States, have served in the industry for at least 15 years, have created a legacy as a positive influence and champion of the industry, and should have achieved the pinnacle of their careers and directionally trend to 60 years old. For posthumous nominations, the individual must have been deceased for at least 12 months prior to the date of the nomination.

Foundation members may submit nominations, a re-nomination or a posthumous nomination and are required to complete the Nomination Form found on the website. More Info The deadline for Nominations is February 1, 2024.
